Useful questions to consider when planning G-AP implementation in your setting...

- 1. Will G-AP information (e.g. G-AP manual) be sent out ahead of the first patient visit? If so, by whom?
- 2. Who will introduce G-AP to the patient? When in the rehab process will this take place?
- 3. Who will complete the initial goal negotiation conversation "Where are you at; where do you want to get to"?
- **4. What role** will **rehabilitation support staff** play in delivering G-AP to patients?
- **5.** How will the G-AP record/ Access G-AP sheets be copied and included within department based records?
- **6.** How will be G-AP goals be discussed at a team level?
- 7. Who will monitor the G-AP process for each patient? A key worker/ other system?
- 8. Will all professional groups within the team be involved in delivering G-AP? If not, will their input feed into the process?
- **9.** What if patients prefer **not to keep** the G-AP record/ Access G-AP at home can in be stored in the team base? **Where**?
- 10. Can you think of other questions relevant to G-AP implementation in your team?
- **11.** Any **other questions** you can think of?
